RE: **JANUARY 2026 FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS**

Executive Summary

General Fund revenues totaled \$9.9 million for the month of January and reflect the spring semester enrollment. Year to date revenues at \$29.2 million were \$59K or 0.2% higher than the prior year after seven months. Year to date revenues at 73% of the annual budget are lower than the previous year as a percentage of budget and slightly higher in actual dollars after seven months (58% of the year). The change in revenue is mainly attributable to the decline in enrollment offset with the new tuition and fee rate as well as the increase in State General Aid. General Fund expenditures totaled \$3.2 million for the month are \$23.0 million year to date, which is 57% of the annual budget. As a result, the College financial position continues to lag that of the previous year with a decrease in the fund balance change from the prior year of \$1.1 million.

Restricted Fund activity for the month of January was routine. The increase in revenue of \$1.3 million is due to additional Local Support, State Support, Federal Support and New Jobs Training Program revenue. Expenditures for the month reflect the expenditures related to the various grant programs.

The Plant Fund activity for the month of January included inter-fund transfers (revenue). The technology transfer provides for the technology needs of the College as well as the laptop computer initiative with funding coming from the student technology fee. Expenditures as a whole increased \$45K mainly related to equipment, debt service for dormitory bond and facility improvement projects.

Auxiliary Enterprise operations in January include spring semester sales and services specific to the bookstores and dormitory operations. Total revenues for the month increased \$1.8 million while expenditures increased \$928K. Overall, the Auxiliary operations in January show a decrease in the fund balance change from the prior year of \$397K.

Cash receipts included tuition and fees, Pell, student loans, bookstore, and dormitory payments all related to the start of the spring semester. Cash and investments on a consolidated basis totaled \$36.2 million at January 31, 2026. The College's investment portfolio's overall yield at 3.29% was down from the 3.45% of the previous month.

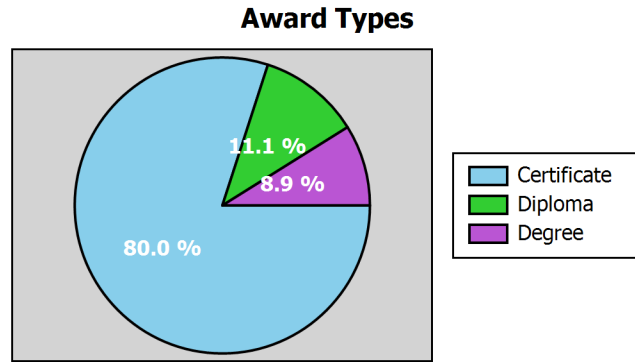

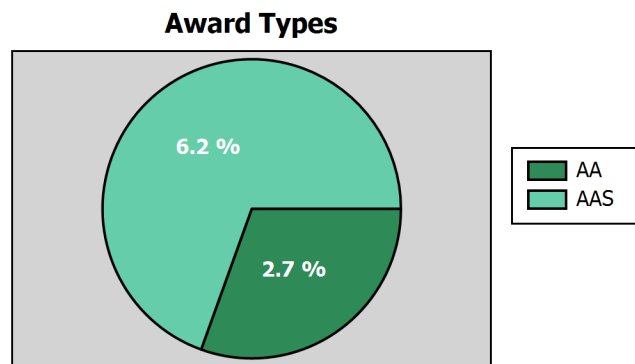

Spring 2026 enrollment reflects continued pressure from regional demographic shifts and workforce dynamics; however, indicators demonstrate that Western Iowa Tech Community College remains stable and is making intentional progress toward long-term sustainability.

Overall Enrollment

Total headcount for all students declined 2.1% to 5,065, while total credit hours declined at a lesser rate of 1.1%, totaling 42,775.5. The smaller decline in credit hours indicates that enrolled students are persisting and maintaining meaningful course engagement as they progress toward completion.

Retention and Student Success

Fall-to-Spring retention for all students reached 75.8%, the highest rate achieved to date. This sustained retention has contributed to WITCC's 50% graduation rate, also the highest in the College's history. College Student Fall-to-Spring retention increased to 87%, reflecting College-wide efforts focused on proactive advising, early alert outreach, re-enrollment strategies, technology enhanced learning environments, targeted and frequent student communications and initiatives designed to reduce financial and academic barriers.

These outcomes are supported by coordinated retention initiatives, including expanded virtual engagement and academic supports, technology-enabled student engagement, and targeted communication campaigns. The near-even distribution of **full-time (50.2%)** and **part-time (49.8%)** students further highlights WITCC's ability to support learners with varying enrollment intensities.

College Student Enrollment

College Student headcount totaled 2,412, a 5% decrease compared to last Spring. Total credit hours declined 3.8%, while average student course load increased slightly, indicating stronger engagement among enrolled students. New College Student enrollment declined in alignment with statewide and national trends, including rural outmigration and a labor market in which job availability continues to exceed workforce supply.

Program and Modality Shifts

Arts & Sciences enrollment declined 11.5%, consistent with a continued shift toward short-term credentials in high-demand Career and Technical Education (CTE) fields supported by Iowa's Free Tuition initiatives. Additionally, WITCC's ongoing efforts to curb enrollment of "ghost students" in fully online Arts & Sciences courses have contributed to lower headcounts in this area.



Online instruction continues to be a critical access point for students. Online credit hours increased 3.2%, and online coursework now represents approximately 51% of total institutional credit hours, reinforcing the importance of continued investment in instructional technology and virtual student services to meet learners where they are.

Concurrent Enrollment Growth

Concurrent enrollment remains a significant area of strength. Spring 2026 Concurrent Student headcount totaled 2,653, with total credit hours increasing 3.7% to 16,412.5. The average concurrent student credit load was **6.2 credits**, indicating increased engagement among concurrently enrolled students.

Expanded Career Academy offerings—particularly in Welding and Agriculture—drove substantial growth, with 465 newly enrolled concurrent students, up from 24 last Spring. CTE concurrent enrollments increased 11.0%, and face-to-face enrollments grew 8.2%.

Outlook

While overall enrollment remains below desired levels, Spring 2026 data indicate that WITCC continues to move in a positive and intentional direction. Continued gains in retention, growth in online credit hours, and expanded concurrent enrollment opportunities—particularly within high-demand CTE pathways—demonstrate the College's ability to adapt to demographic and economic challenges while remaining responsive to community and workforce needs. These trends reinforce WITCC's role as a relevant, resilient, and community-responsive institution positioned for long-term sustainability.

SUBJECT: WITCC Student Outcomes with National Comparisons

Western Iowa Tech Community College (WITCC) typically views student outcomes through three lenses: (1) year-to-year growth and progress within the College, (2) comparison and ranking among community colleges in Iowa, and (3) benchmarking against national peers. To gain national perspective, the College uses data reported to the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) by all institutions receiving federal financial aid. The figures below highlight several WITCC student outcomes compared to a national peer group comprised of 26 community colleges.

Figure 1: Retention rates of full-and part-time, first-time degree seeking students (2023 cohort)

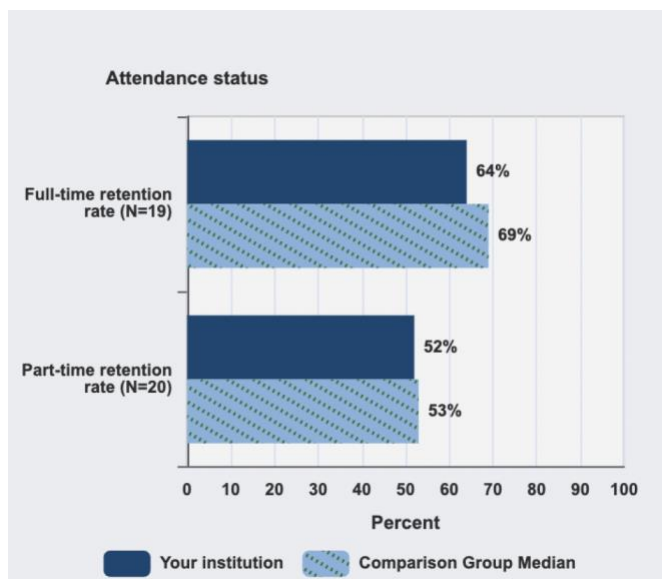


Figure 2: Graduation and transfer-out rates of first-time, full-time degree seekers (2021 cohort)

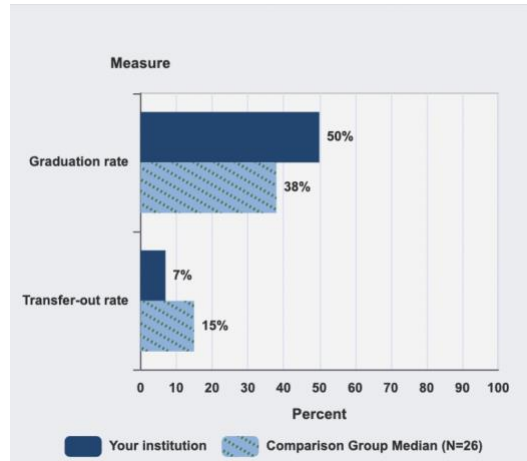


Figure 3: Graduation rates of first-time, full-time degree seekers by race/ethnicity (2021 cohort)

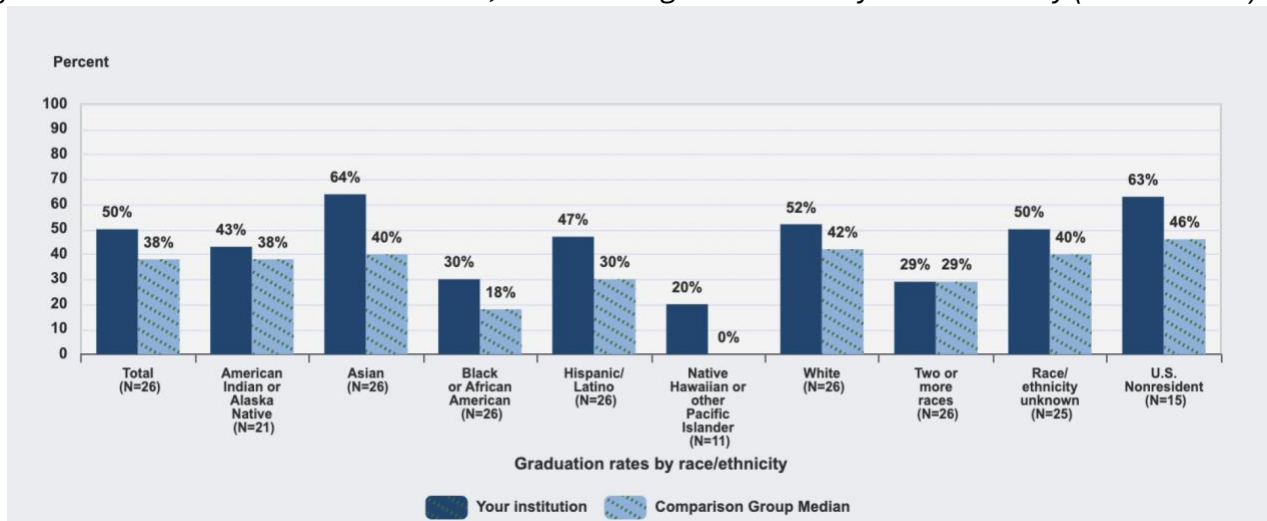


Figure 4: Count of credentials by award type (2023-2024)

At the heart of the Department of Opportunity and Engagement is the College's mission:

"We elevate our diverse learners and strengthen our communities through inclusive and innovative education."

The Department, comprised of nine areas, have driven comprehensive campus engagement and forward-thinking initiatives that foster learning, opportunity and community connection. This report highlights accomplishments throughout this past year rooted in internal operations, student services, external partnerships and professional development.

Internal Accomplishments and Milestones:

A snapshot of accomplishments and milestones within the campus community.

Programmatic & Operational Milestones

- **Adult Basic Education:** The Adult Basic Education (ABE) department, comprised of our High School Equivalency and English Language Learners programs, received a "low risk" program assessment for the 07/01/2024 – 06/30/2025 year. All goals for enrollment, post-testing and measurable skill gains were met. ABE was awarded an additional \$54,000 from the state in November 2025, directly benefiting the educational experience of our students. ABE is also increasing outreach efforts in Cherokee, Ida and Monona counties.
- **English Language Learners:** We continue to offer courses at all three campuses as well as in Le Mars and at Iowa Workforce Development (IWD). IWD experienced a 650% growth in student enrollment. One student made a 15-point gain! Due to federal changes to the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity



Reconciliation Act (PRWORA) of 1996, 53 students were lost and a growing number of community members are ineligible to begin the program. We are actively assessing private pay options for impacted learners. A local employer asked the college to create an on-site English language learning class which is scheduled to begin in January 2026. This was a collaborative effort between Pamela Woolridge, Corporate College, and the local employer.

- **KWIT:** Siouxland Public Media had an unprecedented year in both trials and triumphs. Despite the setback caused by the loss of CBP funding, KWIT had its most successful fund drive in station history in October 2025.
- **Project Success:** Ben Mohning, Director of 4+ Programming, has been meeting with area high schools to discuss the benefits of Project SUCCESS. Project SUCCESS has already seen an increase in enrollment following these efforts, including first time enrollees from our service area.
- **PROPIO Launch:** The College serves visitors, students, and staff with various levels of English language proficiency. To increase more meaningful access, we have contracted with PROPIO to provide on demand interpretation and translation services, including American Sign Language. This was a cross departmental collaboration with Title III, Information Technology, and Admissions.
- **Title IX:** Title IX: Students has been led by Ben Mohning since the Summer of 2025. Ben has formed a team of employee volunteers who will serve as investigators, hearing panel members, and trained advisors. Volunteers have received critical Title IX training and will continue to receive training throughout the calendar year. Ben has also developed a comprehensive procedure handbook, designed and implemented an athletics interest survey, collaborated with other departments to improve reporting and communication, and presented an all-staff professional development session.
- **TRIO Advocacy:** KWIT, Internal Communications, Marketing, Government Relations, faculty, alumni and current students gathered throughout the year to share the impact TRIO Upward Bound, Talent Search and Student Support Services have had on their lives. Both Denison and Sioux City campuses met with Congressional staffers to provide firsthand impact statements and data on how TRIO has enriched each staffers respective service areas.



Events and Engagements

- **American Red Cross “International Humanitarian Law: Understanding Humanity in War”:** The American Red Cross partnered with the College to present on the challenges of war, ethics, and humanity both in the Spring and Fall semester. Both presentations were taught by American Red Cross volunteers that are decorated in combat service as well as trained attorneys. Both presentations had robust turnouts with faculty, staff, administration, Lifelong learners, students and public attending.
- **Fall Festival:** In October 2025, Mike led a collaborative effort to bring forth the College’s first Fall Festival. The event provided fresh squeezed lemonade, sugar cookie decorating, multiple bounce houses for little and big (adult) kids alike, trunk or treat, and a haunted house set up in the Rocklin. The event attracted 250+ campus and local community members and will become an annual fall event.
- **Iowa Law Enforcement Academy Guest Lecturing:** Since 2021, the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy has had State Instructor Naimah Saadiq lecture and conduct certain test outs for our police science students. State Instructor Saadiq was introduced to Western Iowa Tech Community College in February 2021. Saadiq was a panelist on an event cultivated by this department and the City of Sioux City discussing community policing. This strong partnership has provided police science students with increased understanding of community issues, knowledge of various law enforcement careers, and critical access to mentorship opportunities.
- **Special Services Fair:** Developed by Ben Mohning, Director of 4+ Programming, this job fair style event connects community members with special needs and service providers. Since its inception in 2024, the Special Services Fair has grown in participating providers and inspired neighboring towns to provide similar events to which Ben has been invited. Last year, the event was held on March 27, 2025, where 40+ folks with special needs made critical provider connections.
- **Voices of Migration:** A dynamic, collaborative, and well-attended campus-wide event highlighting various aspects of immigration, specifically to obtaining U.S. Citizenship. The event began with a performance of the play “The Courtroom” which reenacts a real woman’s experience with deportation proceedings. Following the performance, a panel discussion was held where College employees shared their journeys to becoming citizens of the United States.



Leadership & Development Initiatives

- **Comet CLASS:** Under the direction of Jennifer McCune, Comet CLASS has set new records of students enrolled, per semester, since its inception in 2023. For Fall 2025, Comet CLASS had 18 members, officially moved into the Center for Inclusive Excellence, and created a “leadership menu” of various projects, directly informed by previous student listening sessions and surveys. Comet CLASS also launched a leadership series open to all students, based around the Broadway show *Hadestown*. Through curated activities, participating students focused on building meaningful connections, developing leadership and advocacy skills, engage in community service and provide a cultural opportunity through artistic performance. Participating students culminated their semester of intentional leadership development with a reflection dinner and attending *Hadestown* at the local Orpheum, where they enjoyed WIT inspired beverages and met the cast and production crew.
- **LIFE Bridge Program:** As a Comprehensive Transition Postsecondary (CTP) program, Leading Individuals toward Fulfilling Employment (LIFE) Bridge program affords students with intellectual and developmental disabilities the opportunity to experience college while building independence needed for meaningful, fulfilling employment. Under Ben Mohning’s direction, LIFE Bridge students will be immersed into the college community, having the same opportunities to learn and engage as any student. This inclusive approach fosters cross-department collaboration, strengthens resource sharing, and builds meaningful partnerships. LIFE Bridge is a powerful reflection of the College’s mission to elevate diverse learners and strengthen our communities through inclusive and innovative education by supporting students with the greatest need for skills development and providing school districts across the country more options to offer their graduates with intellectual and developmental disabilities.
- **Student Activities:** New to the Department of Opportunity and Engagement is Mike Craig, Student Activities Coordinator. Mike Craig, or more affectionately known by students as “Comet Craig,” has worked diligently to provide students engaging and enriching activities in a changing social landscape. Strengthening cross department collaborations, Mike has teamed up with the Library to provide “Crafternoon” events that have served more than 350 students in the library, quickly becoming a beloved student activity offering. Mike has also made a



concerted effort to ensure our English Language Learners also feel included in program offerings. Since moving to the Center for Inclusive Excellence, the collaboration and resource sharing between Comet CLASS and Student Activities has flourished, resulting in more student activity offerings and growth in overall student engagement.

External Collaborations & Community Engagement:

A snapshot of accomplishments and milestones with external community partners, in the spirit of "*strengthening our communities.*"

Community Engagement:

- **Innovation Center:** The Innovation Center will be a state-of-the-art building in downtown Sioux City, dedicated to bringing people together to advance ideas and propel innovation through increased services such as: mentorship, business support, networking, educational opportunities and access to equipment. This is a collaborative undertaking between the City of Sioux City, Western Iowa Tech Community College, Siouxland Public Media and Iowa's West Coast Initiative. Mark Munger, Director of KWIT and Revathi Vongsiprasom, Dean of Opportunity and Engagement, serve on the core group of folks guiding this project alongside Renae Billings, Michelle Bostinelos, Alex Watters, and Anastasia Williams. Linnea Fletcher, Board and Terry Murrell serve on the Board of Directors with voting membership.
- **Border Perspective Trip:** In March 2025, Revathi Vongsiprasom took three TRIO – SSS Students on a career exploration trip to McAllen, Texas. All three students were taking an Immigration Law 101 class, led by Revathi. The project provided firsthand career experience in conducting intakes with persons in need of legal assistance and providing community education to broader communities in McAllen and surrounding towns. Students engaged in servant leadership by volunteering at an array of community agencies, experiencing a wide eco-system of community driven and led supports to help individuals of various immigration statuses, including those with permanent residency and citizenship in the United States. The trip also included meeting with Customs and Border Patrol and visiting the fence between the US and Mexico border.



- **Iowa Jobs for America's Graduates (iJAG):** The College is excited to partner with iJAG and bring their presence back to the Siouxland area. Under the direction of Dr. Christian Supiot, this program will work across multiple departments to ensure retention and career guidance for a caseload between 70 and 90 students.

Conclusion

Through active engagement with our stakeholders, intentional programming, strategic partnerships, and targeted professional development, the Department of Opportunity and Engagement continues to facilitate the college's mission and serving as our community's college.

The Networking and Cyber Security programs have been working over the past year to develop an equipment replacement plan to upgrade programming and curriculum to meet the rapidly changing environment of network security. The planned upgrade of 80 high-end computer units and the server to support those units would serve students in both programs and provide state of the art equipment for those programs. The College's Equipment Purchase Team reviewed the requested plan and approved moving forward with the purchase pending board approval.

The College developed specifications for the equipment and then worked with High Point Networks in identifying suppliers and the best overall purchase. High Point Networks is our trusted networking partner and was instrumental in the design and implementation of our entire network system at WITCC for 15+ years. We partnered with High Point to assist in identifying the most competitive pricing for the equipment required to support our networking and cybersecurity programs. As part of this process, High Point engaged with multiple vendors and conducted pricing comparisons to ensure WITCC received the most cost-effective and appropriate equipment for our instructional needs.

Two quotes are attached with this memo. The first quote from High Point Networks is for the 80 computer system units at a cost of \$395,200. The second quote is for the server to support these units at a cost of \$12,753.

Recommendation

It is the administrative recommendation that the Board approve the purchase of computer systems and the server to support that equipment, from High Point Networks at a total cost of \$407,953. 3&6 cent funds would be used for the purchase.

SIOUX CITY -- One of the first steps in finding a new Western Iowa Tech Community College president is identifying the qualities desired in the individual.

Determining those qualities and developing a presidential profile was the focus of three public forums held on Tuesday at the WITCC campus in Sioux City.

The college has begun the process of finding a replacement for longtime president Terry Murrell, who announced in September he would retire at the end of the school year.

Western Iowa Tech has selected Association of Community College Trustees (ACCT) to assist in the presidential search process. ACCT states they have conducted more than 750 community college searches. Sandy Caldwell, an ACCT search consultant, led the forums on Tuesday.

Caldwell said she attended a community college and said it was "transformative."

"Community colleges, technical colleges, they change generational poverty, right? They're in the life-changing, dream-building business," she said.

Caldwell said ACCT averages 30 to 40 president searches a year, but this year has a record number of searchers due to retirements. She said WITCC's president is a desirable position.

Western Iowa Tech has begun search process for new president

Community members, students, staff and faculty who attended the three forums were asked to identify challenges and opportunities Western Iowa Tech faces in the next few years, the ideal characteristics of the next president and the minimum qualifications the next president should have.

"The presidential profile, this is a really important document. We spend a lot of energy on this and a lot of time on this," Caldwell said. She said the profile allows the search committee to have a good understanding of what is good for the institution, and will guide finalist selection, interviews and final president selection.

The first question asked was what are the challenges and opportunities facing the college in the next three to five years? Attendees were asked to discuss in groups. The students were also asked what their perspective on the challenges and opportunities are.



Some of the common topics across the sessions were enrollment, the recruitment and retention of adult learners, public perception of the institution, the development of the athletics program, technology modernization, improving community engagement, funding and budget, and the changing community demographics.

The second question asked what the ideal characteristics that individuals are seeking in the next president. Caldwell said common topics that came up were having a leader that understands the roles and functions of a technical community college, someone who understands the dynamics that students are facing especially mental health needs, strong financial oversight with experience implementing capital projects, and someone who will be involved in the community.

The next step of the presidential search process involves the search committee meeting and discussing the presidential profile. On Wednesday, the committee will draft the presidential profile, on Thursday the WITCC board of directors will finalize and adopt it and officially open the search on Friday.

Caldwell said eight or nine individuals have already reached out and expressed interest in applying.

The search committee is made up of Linnea Fletcher, Western Iowa Tech board president; Tricia Sutherland, Western Iowa Tech board vice president; Russell Wray, Western Iowa Tech board member; Kim Buryanek, superintendent of Denison Community Schools; Chad Janzen, superintendent of Sergeant Bluff-Luton Community Schools; Barbara Sloniker, Siouxland Chamber of Commerce vice president; Curt Johnson, president of Cherokee State Bank; Troy Jasman, Western Iowa Tech vice president; Frank O'Neill, Western Iowa Tech faculty member; and Asha Loutsch, student leader at Western Iowa Tech.

The application window is expected to end March 2. Finalist interviews are set for April 8 through April 10 with the next president to be announced the week of April 27.
