Brenda Wright called the meeting to order at 3:00 pm.

Abstract of Votes were available for review. Brenda Wright then did the Swearing in of the elected officers.

I. Administrative Reports

2021-2022 Student Senate - Juline introduced Christina and Mike Brown. Mike introduced the 2021-22 Student Senate members.

Marketing Department Update - Juline introduced Andrea to give a marketing update. Andrea reported the exciting year in the Marketing Department. Their biggest project was redesigning the college website. The Annual Report was done total in-house and we saved a lot of money. The Lifelong Learning catalog was redesigned and also received an award. Several marketing campaigns were created for Transfer Majors, College Now Pathways, and Welcome Back Week.

Annual Grants Report and MHRD Economic Development Grant - Juline introduced Michael and Erin. Erin talked about the grants that we applied for and grants won. Provided scholarships, equipment, training dollars, and more.

Michael explained the MHRD - we received \$250,000 will go towards our new Aviation Maintenance Technician program. Will work with Oracle and the Sioux City Schools to build pathways. The program is expected to start Fall 2023. Jeremy Ogle made a motion to approve the contract and Tricia Sutherland seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.

Iowa Adult Education and Literacy - Community Colleges - Contract - Juline introduced Laura Grell - Laura has been working at a state level to work to get our AEL learners get an online program. There is a state-wide Digital initiative to get a better online learning environment to be used across the state of Iowa. Motion to approve contract was made by Derrick Franck and seconded by Jeremy Ogle. All in favor. Motion carried.

Bookstore Relocation Project - Troy explained the plan for the bookstore relocation. Went out for bids and only received one bid which came in \$139,000 over the estimate. We are recommending that we reject the bid and look at project and see if any adjustments can be made. Russ Wray motioned to approve the recommendation to reject the bid. Derrick Franck seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Industrial New Jobs Training Program (NJTP) Status Report for FY21 - Troy explained the NJTP program that started in 1985 to help grow the economy. We issue bonds for companies looking to increase their staff to retrain their workers (1/2) and the other half they can do training inhouse. We report the status of these bonds.

WITCC Training Tower Project Closeout - Troy presented the request to close out the Training Tower Project. If approved, we will release the retainage in 30 days. Tricia Sutherland made a motion to approve and Russ Wray seconded the motion. All were in favor, motion carried.

Identity Theft Prevention Report - Troy introduced Mike Logan and Christy Kleve from FR Secure. We are happy to report we do not have any known issues with identity theft. Mike explained that we have felt secure in the past but our insurance company has decided to get even more protective. We are working with FR Secure to do even more. Christy expressed appreciation for the partnership over the past couple of years. We recently started 2 managed services. We are consulting and meeting throughout the month with IT to discuss our security at WITCC. Always looking to how we can get ahead of the latest threats.

Cyber Security Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) Mike explained the reason that we need MFA. Motion to approve by Jeremy Ogle and seconded by Russ Wray. All in favor. Motion carried

Revised Future Ready Iowa Programs - Darin presented a revised list of Future Ready Iowa programs. IWFD and IDOE updated their list of programs. Linnea Fletcher made a motion to approve the updated list and Neal Adler seconded the motion. All in favor. Motion carried.

Iowa Association of Community College Trustees (IACCT) Report - Derrick - reviewed the summary of the IACCT board meeting. January 26, Student Day on the Hill - Encourage everyone to attend.

Terry Murrell gave his President's Report. He reminded everyone that January will be a virtual board meeting for board members. If you need a practice Zoom session, please contact Mike Logan. Terry also proposed


that our February meeting move to February 14, at 3:00 with a Board Retreat at 1:00. Terry is also planning a New Board Member Orientation session. More info to come.

RE: **DECEMBER 2021 FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS**

Executive Summary

General Fund revenues totaled \$1.4 million for the month of December. Year to date revenues totaled \$17.7 million after six months. Overall, General Fund revenues are approximately \$625K or 3.7% higher than last year. Due to the timing of the start of the spring semester and the community education courses, the tuition and fees attributable to the spring semester are not included in the December financials. Year to date revenue at 50% of the annual budget is higher than the previous year as a percentage of budget and in actual dollars after six months (50% of the year). General Fund expenditures totaled \$2.8 million for the month and \$15.9 million year to date. Year to date expenditures at 45% of the annual budget are consistent with budget expectations while slightly higher than that of the prior fiscal year in percentage of budget and in terms of actual dollars after six months (50% of the year). As a result, the College's financial position exceeds that of the previous year with an increase in the fund balance change from the prior year of \$160K.

Restricted Fund activity for the month of December was routine. The only notable activity is the increase in state and federal support of \$406K for the various state and federal programs and the increase in salaries and related costs, services, material, supplies and travel, and other current expenditures related to these various grant programs.

Plant Fund activity for the month of December included revenue of \$111K and expenditures of \$449K. The increase in expenditures was mainly attributable to equipment and building projects as well as interest on dormitory revenue bonds.

Overall, Auxiliary Enterprise operations in December show an increase in the fund balance of \$161K from the prior year. Again, this increase is mainly due to the accounting change of reclassifying student organizations and clubs within the Auxiliary Fund. This aligns with the change made to the prior year as an audit requirement. Auxiliary revenues increased \$44K for the month while expenditures increased \$169K.

The College's cash flow included receipts of \$7.6 million and disbursements of \$7.3 million for the month. Cash and investments on a consolidated basis totaled \$47.1 million at December 31, 2021, an increase of \$254K from November. The College's investment portfolio's overall yield at 0.19% was down from the 0.21% of the previous month.

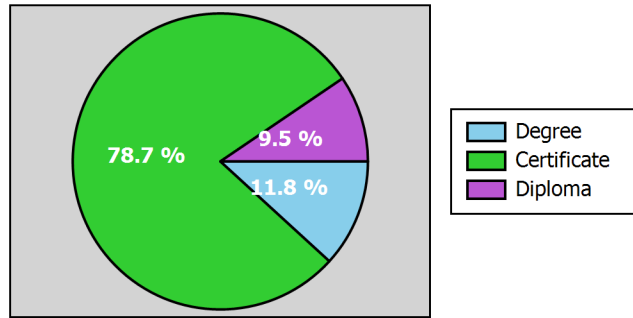

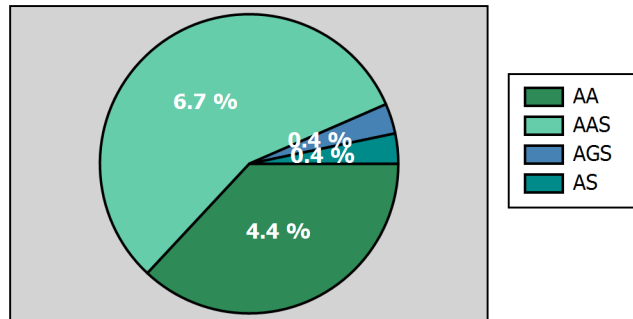

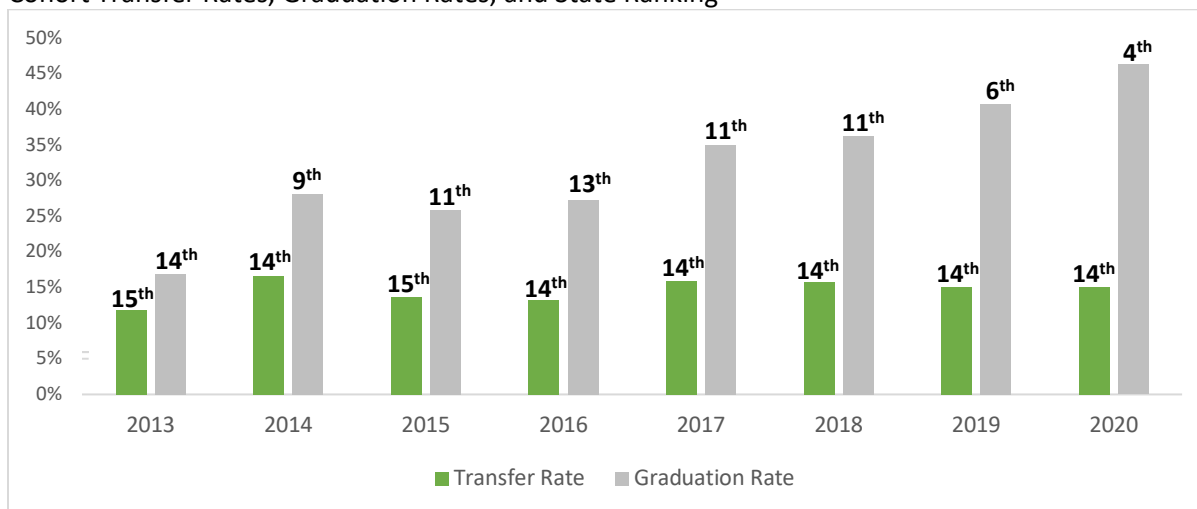

SUBJECT: Annual Transfer Report

As a comprehensive community college, transfer is a critical component of the Western Iowa Tech Community College mission. However, the absence of a dominant, local, in-state transfer institution has limited the College’s ability to successfully fulfill this mission. While overall completion at the College has increased dramatically in recent years, transfer rates have remained relatively low and stagnant.

Roughly half of students completing a transfer pathway (Arts & Sciences or Transfer Major) follow through with transfer by the first fall after graduation. **CONTRACT BETWEEN
McCook Central School District
AND
WESTERN IOWA TECH COMMUNITY COLLEGE**

This Contract establishes the terms and extent of a relationship between McCook Central School District and Western Iowa Tech Community College for the purpose of providing concurrent enrollment for college level courses to high school students. This instrument describes the scope of this contractual relationship.

SECTION I

TITLE OF CONTRACT: Concurrent Enrollment Contract for College Level Courses

SECTION II

CONTRACT AGENCIES: Provider: Western Iowa Tech Community College (WITCC)
Participant: McCook Central School District

SECTION III

UNDERSTANDING AND PURPOSE OF THE CONTRACT:

Western Iowa Tech Community College and McCook Central School District agrees to enter into a Contract. The purpose of this contract is to assist specified secondary students in receiving college credit career education training/courses and to utilize the expertise of WITCC in providing such college level instruction. Whereas, pursuant to Chapter 261E, "Senior Year Plus" and 260C.18A of the Code of Iowa, WITCC and the McCook Central School District for mutual consideration and benefits agree to provide joint services and facilities on the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth.

SECTION IV

TERM OF COMMITMENT:

The Western Iowa Tech Community College's calendar shall be the calendar for college credit instruction taught at the WITCC campus, online or other methods of distance education. The participant and provider will jointly determine the annual calendar for courses offered at the participant's location.

Beginning Date: August 1, 2021

End Date: July 31, 2022

SECTION V

FACILITIES, STUDENTS, PERSONNEL AND SERVICES:

A. Facilities:

- (1) By the Provider: The Provider agrees to provide facilities located at a WITCC campus.
- (2) By the Participant: The Participant agrees to provide facilities located at the high school.

B. Students and Personnel:

(1) By the Provider: The Provider shall provide administrative, supervisory, instructional, coordinating and other necessary staff to carry out the purposes of the project. The College's Instructional Leaders will visit classes to assess the delivery of instruction. WITCC will employ a High School Relations representative to provide coordination, planning and direction for all jointly administered programs. The Provider shall make available to the Participant staff members for consultative purposes as needed for activities related to this project. Policies and procedures in the WITCC Student Handbook and course syllabus will be administered. The student rules and regulations of the Participant will supplement the Provider's rules and regulations. The Provider will contribute support services, including career exploration, career guidance, and transition information and support.

(2) By the Participant: The Participant will provide properly screened and counseled students for enrollment in courses offered in this project. The rules, regulations and personnel policies of the Provider shall apply to project personnel and students. The Participant shall make staff members available for consultative purposes as needed for activities related to this project. The Participant agrees to facilitate the completion of the student application for admission and the student enrollment form and return both forms to the Provider on or before the agreed upon start of the semester. The Participant will ensure that instructors employed by the Participant complete an orientation with the Provider and attend at least one development session administered by the Provider each academic year.

**SECTION VI
INSTRUCTIONAL AND RELATED SERVICES:**

- A. By the Provider: The Provider shall make available career/college transfer courses, activities and programs to the Participant's students. College credit instructional offerings shall have been approved by governing board(s) of the Provider and by the Iowa Department of Education. The Provider will provide counseling services as well as admission, registration and record-keeping services to supplement those same services provided by the Participant. The Provider will develop and maintain the curricula.
- B. By the Participant: Instructional programs/courses taught at the participant's location will be jointly determined by the Participant and Provider based on need, interest and demand as determined by the Participant and subsequently approved by the Provider. The participant will ensure only instructors approved by the provider are delivering classroom instruction and will work with Provider to ensure courses are delivered with the appropriate rigor and environment consistent with the expectations of the Provider. The Participant is responsible for all consumable expenses and equipment associated with the course. If mutually agreed, the Provider may assist in initial equipment costs.

**SECTION VII
SPECIFIC TERMS OF THE CONTRACT:**

A. Courses taught on a WITCC campus, online or distance delivery format within the Fall 2021 and Spring 2022 terms.

By the Participant: The Participant agrees to the following:

- (1) Pay costs as follows: \$134/credit hour enrolled
- (2) Pay the Provider within 30 days for any costs billed to the Participant.

By the Provider: The Provider agrees to the following:

- (1) Provide instructional materials required for the course.
- (2) Provide a qualified instructor at the expenses of the Provider.
- (3) Serve as the fiscal agent to establish and maintain the budget.
- (4) Administer the jointly shared programs of instruction.
- (5) Develop and maintain college approved curricula.
- (6) Facilitate enrollment of students.

B. Courses taught at the Participant's location or at a WITCC campus restricted to concurrently enrolled students within the Fall 2021 and Spring 2022 terms.

By the Participant: The Participant agrees to the following:

- (1) Pay for college course offerings (per section) as follows:
 - (a) Instructional costs (includes salary, fringe benefits, and mileage if applicable)
 - (b) Credit services (includes registration, tuition/fees, etc.)
Cost: \$800 Section Fee, plus \$80 per student enrolled
The Section Fee is waived for the 3rd and any subsequent sections taught in a specific course by a specific instructor within the Participant's academic semester.
 - (c) Textbook(s) costs, if applicable
 - (d) Consumable expenses incurred by the Provider, if applicable.
 - (e) Equipment expenses incurred by the Provider, if applicable.
- (2) Pay the Provider within 30 days for any costs billed to the Participant, as outlined above.

By the Provider: The Provider agrees to the following:

- (1) Serve as the fiscal agent to establish and maintain the budget.
- (2) Administer the jointly shared programs of instruction.
- (3) Review and approve prospective instructors.
- (4) Develop and maintain college approved curricula.
- (5) Provide site/class visits by College instructional leader(s) to assess the delivery of instruction.
- (6) Facilitate enrollment of students.
- (7) Work with each Participant to maximize the positive impact of this partnership in each community.
- (8) Provide orientation to new instructors and deliver at least two development sessions for instructors in the program each academic year.
- (9) Maintain academic records for each participating student.

**ACCELERATED CAREER EDUCATION
PROGRAM AGREEMENT**

This Accelerated Career Education ("ACE") Program Agreement (the "Agreement") made and entered into as of the date set forth below between Western Iowa Tech Community College, (Merged Area X11), Sioux City, Iowa ("College"), and the entity set forth below ("Employer"), under the following circumstances:

A. Pursuant to the Accelerated Career Education Program Act, Iowa Code Chapter 260G, Western Iowa Tech Community College, and Employer enter into this Agreement for the purpose of educating and training certain persons to provide highly skilled and well educated workers within the Merged Area.

B. Western Iowa Tech Community College and Employer each has full right and lawful authority to enter into this Agreement and to perform and observe the provisions hereof on their respective parts to be performed and observed.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the mutual representations and agreements hereinafter contained, the parties hereto agree as follows:

**ARTICLE I
DEFINITIONS**

Section 1.1. "ACE Program" shall consist of this arrangement to provide Program Services as more specifically set forth on **Exhibit "A"** for a career program pursuant to this Agreement with respect to Program Job Positions.

Section 1.2. "Act" means the Accelerated Career Education Program Act, Iowa Code Chapter 260G, as it may be amended from time to time, and the regulations promulgated thereunder by the Iowa Economic Development Authority, as the regulations may be amended from time to time.

Section 1.3. "Program Costs" means all necessary and incidental costs of providing Program Services. Attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"** and incorporated herein by this reference is a tentative budget relating to the ACE Program.

Other terms used in this Agreement shall have the meanings set out in the Act. Definitions set out in Iowa Code Chapter 260G are attached hereto.

**ARTICLE II
ACE PROGRAM**

Section 2.1. Western Iowa Tech Community College agrees to provide the Program Services to the extent of funds available for that purpose. It is understood and agreed that Employer and any employee of Employer who represents a Program Job will assist in developing

the Program. If Employer has a bargaining agreement in place, a representative of the employee bargaining unit shall also take part in the development of the Program. Western Iowa Tech Community College will be responsible for the final design of the Program.

Section 2.2. Western Iowa Tech Community College and Employer agree that Program Costs may be paid from one or a combination of the following sources: (a) cash or in-kind contributions by the Employer toward the program cost, provided that the Employer contribution shall be no less than twenty percent of the program costs, (b) tuition, student fees, or special charges fixed by the board of trustees to defray program costs, and (c) guarantee by the Employer of payments to be received under paragraph "a".

Section 2.3. The term of this Agreement shall not exceed five (5) years from the date of this Agreement. This Agreement may be renewed for a period not to exceed two (2) years.

Section 2.4. This Agreement may be amended with the written consent of both parties, provided that the parties shall not amend the term of this Agreement.

Section 2.5. Western Iowa Tech Community College may revise or expand the Program from time to time. However, no revision shall be made which would change the purpose of the Program to a purpose that is not permitted by the Act. Western Iowa Tech Community College may revise the Program Costs to reflect changes in tuition, other fees, changes in salaries and expenses and other increases allowed by law. Program Costs shall be calculated or recalculated on an annual basis based on the required Program Services and for a specific number of Participant Positions.

ARTICLE III PAYMENTS

Section 3.1. **Exhibit "A"** sets forth the minimum annual amount of Employer contribution and tuition and fee payments to be paid for Program Costs. Employer contributions shall be made according to the schedule set forth on **Exhibit "A."**

ARTICLE IV COVENANTS, REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES

Section 4.1. Representations, Warranties and Covenants of Western Iowa Tech Community College. Western Iowa Tech Community College represents that:

- (a) it is duly organized and validly existing under the laws of the State of Iowa;
- (b) it is not in violation of or in conflict with any provisions of the laws of the State of Iowa which would impair its ability to carry out its obligations hereunder;
- (c) it is empowered to enter into the transactions contemplated by this Agreement; and
- (d) it will do all things required of it in order to maintain its existence or assure the assumption of its obligations hereunder by any successor public body.

Section 4.2. Representations, Warranties and Covenants of Employer. Employer represents, warrants and covenants that:

- (a) It is authorized to do business in the State of Iowa;
- (b) It has full power and authority to execute, deliver and perform this Agreement and all other instruments to secure its performance and to enter into and carry out the transactions contemplated herein. Such execution, delivery and performance are not in contravention of law or Employer's articles of incorporation, bylaws or any indenture, agreement, mortgage, lease, undertaking or any other restriction, obligation or instrument to which Employer is a party or by which it is bound. This Agreement has by proper action been duly authorized, executed and delivered by Employer and all steps necessary have been taken to constitute this Agreement a valid and binding obligation of Employer;
- (c) There is no litigation or proceeding pending, or to the knowledge of Employer threatened, against Employer or any other person affecting in any manner whatsoever the right of Employer to execute the Agreement or to otherwise comply with its obligations contained in the Agreement;
- (d) Employer is a business or consortium of businesses, as that term is defined in the Act, and is engaged in interstate or intrastate commerce for the purpose of manufacturing, processing or assembling products, construction, conducting research and development, or providing services (other than retail) in interstate or intrastate commerce;
- (e) Employer will interview graduating participants for full-time positions with Employer and will provide future hiring preferences to graduates of the ACE Program provided for in this Agreement;
- (f) If Employer has more than four sponsored participants in the program, Employer will offer a Program Job position of full-time employment to at least twenty-five percent of those sponsored participants who successfully complete the ACE Program;
- (g) Employer will provide for a wage level for Program Jobs of no less than two hundred percent of the Federal Poverty Guidelines for a family of two as defined by the most recently revised poverty income guidelines as published by the United States Department of Health and Human Services at the time the Agreement is entered into. The wage level shall be recertified each year on the anniversary of the effective date of the Agreement; and
- (h) Employer's projection of the annual gross wages to be paid by Employer to employees in the Program Jobs is truly and accurately depicted on **Exhibit "A"**.

ARTICLE V EVENTS OF DEFAULT

Section 5.1. Events of Default. Each of the following shall be an "event of default":

(a) Employer fails to pay any amount required of it on or prior to the date on which such payment is due and payable and continuing for more than five (5) business days thereafter.

(b) Employer fails to observe and perform any other agreement, representation, term or condition contained in this Agreement, if such failure is not cured within twenty (20) days after Colleges provides notice of such failure to Employer, or for such longer period to which Western Iowa Tech Community College may agree in writing; provided, that if the failure is other than the payment of money and is of such nature that it cannot be corrected within the applicable period, such failure shall not constitute an event of default so long as Employer institutes curative action within the applicable period and diligently pursues such action to completion.

(c) Any representation or warranty made by Employer herein or any statement in any report, certificate, financial statement or other instrument furnished in connection with this Agreement is, at any time, proven to have been false or misleading in any material respect when made or given.

(d) Employer acts in a manner contrary to any provision of this Agreement or fails to act in a manner required by any provision of this Agreement.

Section 5.2. Whenever an event of default shall have happened and is not cured as provided above, Western Iowa Tech Community College may, without notice to Employer, terminate this Agreement. In addition, Western Iowa Tech Community College may take whatever other action at law or in equity may appear necessary or desirable to collect the payments due and other amounts then due and thereafter to become due under this Agreement and to enforce performance and observance of any other obligation or agreement of Employer under this Agreement.

Section 5.3. No remedy conferred upon or reserved to Western Iowa Tech Community College by this Agreement is intended to be exclusive of any other available remedy or remedies, but each and every such remedy shall be cumulative and shall be in addition to every other remedy now or hereafter existing at law, in equity or by statute. No delay or omission to exercise any right or power accruing upon any default shall impair any such right or power or shall be construed to be a waiver thereof, but any such right and power may be exercised from time to time and as often as may be deemed expedient. In order to entitle Western Iowa Tech Community College to exercise any remedy reserved to it in this Article, it shall not be necessary to give any notice, other than such notice as may be expressly required herein, nor shall it be necessary to make any declaration of an event of default other than such declaration as may be expressly required herein.

Section 5.4. In the event any provision contained in this Agreement should be breached by either party and thereafter waived by the other party, such waiver shall be limited to the particular breach so waived and shall not be deemed to be a waiver of any other breach hereunder.

Section 5.5. Employer may decline to satisfy any provisions in this Agreement relating to Subsection 4.2(e) and Subsection 4.2(f) of this Agreement if Employer experiences an economic downturn. For purposes of this Section, "economic downturn" includes a layoff of existing employees, reduced employment levels, increased inventories, or reduced sales.

ARTICLE VI MISCELLANEOUS

Section 6.1. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which shall be regarded as an original and all of which shall constitute but one and the same instrument.

Section 6.2. If any provision of this Agreement, or any covenant, stipulation, obligation, agreement, act or action, or part thereof made, assumed, entered into or taken thereunder or any application thereof, is for any reason held to be illegal or invalid, such illegality or invalidity shall not affect any other provision or any other covenant, stipulation, obligation, agreement, act or action or part thereof, made, assumed, entered into, or taken, each of which shall be construed and enforced as if such illegal or invalid portion were not contained herein, nor shall such illegality or invalidity of any application thereof affect any legal and valid application thereof, and each such provision, covenant, stipulation, obligation, agreement, act or action, or part shall be deemed to be effective, operative, made, entered into or taken in the manner and to the full extent permitted by law.

Section 6.3. This Agreement shall be governed exclusively by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Iowa. The applicable provisions of Iowa law, including the Act, are incorporated into this Agreement as if set forth herein.

Section 6.4. All notices, requests or other communications hereunder shall be in writing and shall be deemed to be sufficiently given when mailed by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, addressed to the appropriate Notice Address set forth on the signature page of this Agreement.

Employer and Western Iowa Tech Community College may, by notice given hereunder, designate any further or different addresses or persons to which subsequent notices, requests or other communications shall be sent.

Section 6.5. All covenants, stipulations, obligations and agreements of Western Iowa Tech Community College and Employer contained in this Agreement shall be effective to the extent authorized and permitted by applicable law. No such covenant, stipulation, obligation or agreement shall be deemed to be a covenant, stipulation, obligation or agreement of any present or future member, officer, agent or employee of Western Iowa Tech Community College or the Board of Trustees of Western Iowa Tech Community College other than in his or her official capacity, and neither the members of the Board of Trustees of Western Iowa Tech Community College nor any official, agent or employee of Western Iowa Tech Community College shall be liable personally on the covenants, stipulations, obligations or agreements of Western Iowa Tech Community College contained in this Agreement.

Section 6.6. This Agreement shall inure to the benefit of and shall be binding in accordance with its terms upon Western Iowa Tech Community College, Employer and their respective permitted successors and assigns, provided that this Agreement may not be assigned by Employer without the written consent of Western Iowa Tech Community College.

Section 6.7. Employer agrees that it shall provide all information requested by Western Iowa Tech Community College, the Iowa Economic Development Authority ("IEDA"), Iowa Workforce Development ("IWD") or the Iowa Department of Education ("IDOE") for the purpose of establishing a consistent and meaningful database to track aggregate wages of employees over time and evaluate the effectiveness of job training programs. Such information shall include the Social Security numbers of all Participants hired by Employer for Program Jobs. Such information shall be provided directly to Western Iowa Tech Community College, IEDA, IWD, or IDOE upon forms provided by Western Iowa Tech Community College or IEDA, IWD, or IDOE.

Section 6.8. Employer acknowledges that pursuant to the Act, Western Iowa Tech Community College may enter into similar agreements with other employers.

Section 6.9. This Agreement, including Exhibits, constitutes the entire agreement between Western Iowa Tech Community College and Employer with respect to the subject matter hereof and as such supersedes all previous negotiations, commitments and understandings. Captions and the alignment of the Agreement are for convenience only and shall not be construed to modify the rights or obligations of the parties.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, Western Iowa Tech Community College and Employer have caused this Agreement to be duly executed all as of the date set forth below.

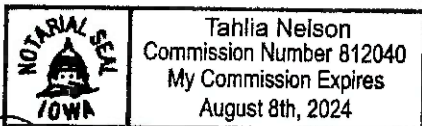

RE: **COLLEGE FACILITIES PROJECTS**

Over the past year, the College has been able to complete a number of projects. This report is to update the Board on what has been completed this past year as well as pending projects. Dr. Murrell charged the facilities team to look at areas of the College that we would not be proud of to show off to students, staff or community members. With that charge, the committee which is made up of Physical Plant, Information Technology, Education, Outlying Campus and Administrative members meet to make sure that the needs of the College are met. In addition to these projects, the Equipment Team meets to secure instructional equipment needs of the programs.

Completed Projects

Enrollment Services Renovation – This project provided a complete refresh of the space as well as installing sprinkler system. Project also included creating space for the Coffee Spot.

Hallway outside of Cargill Auditorium – Covered the concrete block, replaced ceiling tiles and installed new lighting.

The Security Institute Building Switch Gear – Replaced the electrical switch gear to update to current electrical demand.

Cherokee Campus Signage – Replaced the outdated lighted sign in the front lawn area with letters on building.

Denison Campus Classroom Furniture – Purchased new tables and chairs for classrooms.

Le Mars Storage Facility – Storage facility items were purged and organized.

Mapleton – Staff worked on front entrance landscape.

Industrial Technology Center – Classrooms, hallways and student lounge area all received new flooring and paint. Classroom furniture updated were requested.

Hallway Refresh – Replaced ceiling tiles and lights in hallway outside of Human Resources. Also updated colored tiles in flooring.

Student Clinic – Created two exam rooms for College Student Clinic.

Tiered Lecture Rooms – Covered concrete block walls, replaced ceiling tiles and lights, replaced flooring, updated laminate on tables and installed technology to meet instruction needs.

Dormitory Wireless Project – Updated the access points to provide desired wireless signal coverage for housing students.

The Security Institute Building Classroom Refresh – Covered concrete block walls, installed new flooring, removed outdated lockers, installed new ceiling tiles and lights and purchased new tables to meet the instructional needs.

Cherokee Campus Auto Program – Created an auto lab in space previously used as a conference center.

Soft Seating – College continues to add soft seating to student areas. Have removed the concrete base seating. Will continue to add to areas around campus.

Information Technology Refresh – Updated area with new paint and carpet. Replaced kitchenette cabinets.

Overlook Café Refresh – Updated ceiling tiles and lights, carpeting and purchased new tables and chairs.

Corporate College Safety Training Tower – Created a safety training tower for Corporate College training needs for business and industry.

Sun Ridge Court Retaining Wall and Landscape Project – Installed a retaining wall to improve drainage as well as updating the landscaping. Installed a patio outside of the community room for student use.

Entrance 7 and 8 – Updated the landscaping at entrances to the Corporate College Building.

Wellness Center Refresh – Covered the concrete block walls to improve the feel of the area.

Outlying Campus Vehicles – Added minivans to both Cherokee and Denison campuses to meet the needs of the students.

Conference Room – Created a conference room near the Cargill Auditorium.

Projects Currently Underway

Switch Gear Replacement in Dr. Robert H. Kiser Building – This project is to replace the original switch gear in the building. Project is nearly completed. Will finalize in the spring with a planned electrical outage.

Digital Water Curtain – Installation of a programmable digital water curtain near the main entrance. Water curtain has arrived and will be installed this spring.

Cherokee Nursing Simulation Lab/Classroom – Will create a simulation lab as well as updated classroom in space previously used as a conference center. Project will be completed for fall semester start.

Roof Replacement on Applied Technology Building – Replacement of roof as previous roof was nearing end of useful life.

Continuation of Hallway Refresh – Will continue to replace ceiling tiles and lighting in hallways. Will remove dated colored floor tiles.

KWIT Building Refresh – Working with the College radio station to renovate the space to meet the needs of a modern day radio station. Project will consist of new ceilings and lights, flooring, redesigned areas and furniture.

Additional Video Wall – Removed outdated display case to install video wall to communicate to students as well as showcase College events.

Planned Projects

Cherokee Campus Landscape – Will refresh the landscape at the main entrance to the campus as well as correcting some concrete issues.

Denison Campus Landscape – Will refresh the landscape at the main entrance to the campus as well as correcting some drainage issues.

Sun Ridge Court Dormitory Siding – Will replace the siding, windows, soffits and doors.

Bookstore Relocation – Have plans in place for relocation of campus bookstore to area near the front entrance. Bid came in over the estimate. College looking at alternative options.

Atrium Area – Will refresh the carpet, ceiling tiles, lights and furniture. Space is heavily used by students.

Library Refresh – Will replace the carpet in the circulation desk area. Will replace circulation desk as well as provide a feature wall across from the desk.

Nursing Simulation Lab – Will create a nursing simulation lab on the main campus to better met the instructional and clinical needs of the program.

Gaylord Smith Building Roof Replacement – Will replace existing roof as it has is at the end of useful life. This will complete campus building roof replacements.

Cargill Auditorium Refresh – Would like to replace carpeting, lighting and seating in auditorium. Area has not been renovated in over thirty years.

Corporate College Training Room Refresh – Will cover the concrete block walls with sheetrock and remove outdated folding wall.

Large Tiered Classrooms – Will cover the concrete block walls, replace ceiling tiles and lighting, replace flooring and laminate on tables. Will install technology to meet instructional needs.

RE: **STATEWIDE COMPARISON OF PERCENTAGE OF REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES**

A report showing the comparison of percentage of revenues and expenditures for Western Iowa Tech Community College to all the community colleges within the state of Iowa is attached. This information was obtained from a Department of Education report. Five years of General Fund information is included to show where the college has been and where we have seen changes. Included in the last column is fiscal year 1996, our initial tracking year, to show a longer term view.

Due to the COVID-19 funding the College received during FY21, the revenue percentages are impacted by the large increase in the Other Income category. Depending on when the other community colleges recorded the COVID-19 funds, the comparison data could be skewed. Tuition and fees revenue now accounts for nearly 45.5% of the revenue for the General Fund. WITCC's percentage of revenue from tuition and fees decreased this past year due to enrollment and COVID-19 funding. Revenue from tuition and fees continues to reflect the College's strong dependency on this source of revenue. The College continues to receive less local support (property tax) than the statewide average. The State Support flat funding is also skewed by the COVID-19 funding. The Federal Support line reflects the additional funding that the College receives for KWIT-KOJI as not all community colleges have radio stations. The Other Income percentage increase reflects some of the College grants, College Now program and the influx of COVID-19 funding.

The expenditures were also impacted and skewed by the COVID-19 funding. The expenditures continue to reflect the college's strong heritage in vocational technical education. The Physical Plant expenditures are greatly impacted by COVID-19 funding for facility needs. The General Institution line continues to reflect the changing technological demands placed on the college.

Expenditures by category show how management at the college has continued to contain salary cost. The decrease in Salaries reflects the cost reduction due to retirements and unfilled positions. The Services expenditure line represents contracted services utilized at the College. Current expenditures are reflective of the cost of the technology and facility needs of the College. The Current Expenses also includes the transfer to the Plant Fund for the laptop computer initiative that is unique to Western Iowa Tech Community College.
