There were no oral communications brought to the Board.

RE: **DECEMBER 2022 FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS**

Executive Summary

General Fund revenues totaled \$1.4 million for the month of December. Year to date revenues totaled \$18.3 million after six months. Overall, General Fund revenues are approximately \$375K or 2.1% higher than last year. Due to the timing of the start of the spring semester and the community education courses, the tuition and fees attributable to the spring semester are not included in the December financials. Year to date revenue at 51% of the annual budget is higher than the previous year as a percentage of budget and in actual dollars after six months (50% of the year). General Fund expenditures totaled \$2.8 million for the month and \$16.2 million year to date. Year to date expenditures at 45% of the annual budget are consistent with budget expectations while slightly higher than that of the prior fiscal year in terms of actual dollars after six months (50% of the year). As a result, the College's financial position exceeds that of the previous year with an increase in the fund balance change from the prior year of \$113K.

Restricted Fund activity for the month of December was routine. The only notable activity is the increase in state and federal support of \$561K for the various state and federal programs and the increase in salaries and related costs, services, material, supplies and travel, and other current expenditures related to these various grant programs.

Plant Fund activity for the month of December included revenue of \$134K and expenditures of \$111K. The increase in expenditures was mainly attributable to equipment and building projects as well as interest on dormitory revenue bonds.

Overall, Auxiliary Enterprise operations in December show a slight decrease in the fund balance change of \$9K from the prior year. Auxiliary revenues increased \$64K for the month while expenditures increased \$266K.

The College's cash flow included receipts of \$6.1 million and disbursements of \$7.8 million for the month. Cash and investments on a consolidated basis totaled \$47.6 million at December 31, 2022, a decrease of \$1.6 million from November. The College's investment portfolio's overall yield at 1.88% was up from the 1.63% of the previous month.

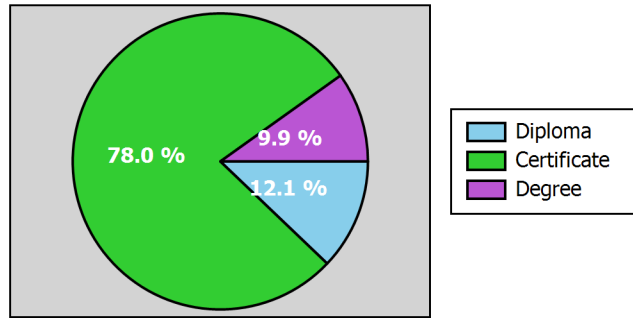

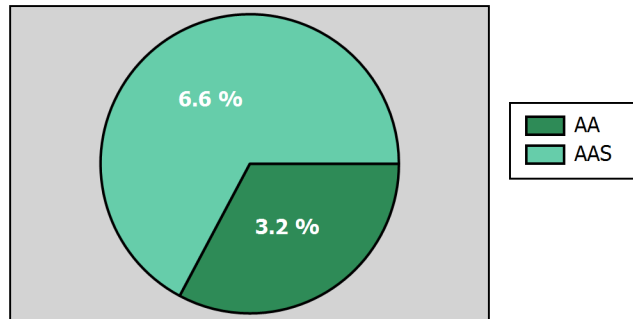

Over the past year, the College has been able to complete a number of projects. This report is to update the Board on what has been completed this past year as well as pending projects. Dr. Murrell charged the facilities team to look at areas of the College that we would not be proud of to show off to students, staff or community members. With that charge, the committee which is made up of Physical Plant, Information Technology, Education, Outlying Campus and Administrative members meet to make sure that the needs of the College are met. In addition to these projects, the Equipment Team meets to secure instructional equipment needs of the programs.

Completed Projects

Cherokee Nursing Simulation Lab/Classroom – The project created a simulation lab as well as an updated classroom in space previously used as a conference center.

Chemistry Fume Hood Project – Refreshed the chemistry lab with sheetrock and new fume hoods.

General Classroom Refresh – Continuation of replacing worn carpet, lights and ceiling tiles as well as new paint.

Digital Water Curtain – Installation of a programmable digital water curtain near the main entrance. Has created an impressive feature.

Roof Replacement on Applied Technology Building – Replacement of roof as previous roof was nearing end of useful life.

Hallway Refresh – Have completed several hallways with updating the colored tiles in the flooring.

Switch Gear Replacement in Dr. Robert H. Kiser Building – This project replaced the original switch gear in the building.

Additional Video Wall – Removed outdated display case to install video wall to communicate to students as well as showcase College events.

Sun Ridge Court Dormitory Siding – Replaced the siding, windows, soffits and doors at three buildings.

Corporate College Training Room Refresh – Covered the concrete block walls with sheetrock and removed outdated folding wall.

Library Refresh – Replaced the carpet in the circulation desk area as well as replacing the circulation desk.

Comet Sign – Completed a Comet Sign near the KWIT/KOJI Building.

Sun Ridge Court Parking Lot – This project installed an asphalt overlay over the existing surface to extend the life of the road.

Overlook Café Refresh – Updated the serving area with new paint, ceiling tiles and lights.

Gaylord Smith Storm Sewer Project – This project corrected some erosion issues located at the rear of the building.

Projects Currently Underway

Continuation of Hallway Refresh – Will continue to replace outdated colored floor tiles.

Bookstore Relocation – Project to relocate the current bookstore to near the front entrance. Project to start December 19, 2022 with a completion date of May 15, 2023.

Gaylord Smith Building Roof Replacement – Will replace existing roof as it has is at the end of useful life. This will complete campus building roof replacements. Project now scheduled to begin spring 2023.

Cargill Auditorium Refresh – Replacing the wall covering, painting ceiling and replacing worn carpet. Area has not been renovated in over thirty years. Working on grant opportunities to replace seating.

Cherokee Campus Landscape – Will refresh the landscape at the main entrance to the campus as well as correcting some concrete issues. This is a spring 2023/summer 2023 project.

Denison Campus Landscape – Will refresh the landscape at the main entrance to the campus as well as correcting some drainage issues. This is a spring 2023/summer 2023 project.

Sun Ridge Court Dormitory Siding – Will replace the siding, windows, soffits and doors at two buildings. This will complete five of the ten buildings.

Dr. Robert H. Kiser Chiller Replacement – This project will replace the outdated chiller for a large portion of the main campus building. Project is now scheduled for spring 2033 due to supply chain issues.

Soft Seating – Additional soft seating areas for students to gather around campus.

Rocklin Conference Center Stage – This project will create a permanent stage in the Rocklin Conference Center that is compliant with the American with Disabilities Act.

Cherokee Campus Lobby – This project is to refresh the lobby with sheetrock to cover the existing block, remove the outdated display cases and install television monitors.

Switch Gear Replacement in Applied Technology Building – This project is to replace the original switch gear in the building.

Planned Projects

Center for Equity, Diversity and Inclusion – This project is currently being planned with the architects.

Denison Career Academy – Will create a career academy on the Denison campus. Preliminary work with the architects and partners has started.

Nursing Simulation Lab – Will create a nursing simulation lab on the main campus to better met the instructional and clinical needs of the program.

Large Tiered Classrooms – Will cover the concrete block walls, replace ceiling tiles and lighting, replace flooring and laminate on tables. Will install technology to meet instructional needs.

ESL Area – Will update the space to better serve the needs of our students. Will include new flooring, ceilings, lights as well as adding offices and furniture.

Testing Center Refresh – Will update the space with flooring, ceilings, lights and potentially new furniture.

Parking Lot 5 and Lot 6 Replacement – This project is to replace the worn parking lots with new concrete. Will also have new islands, plants and lighting.

As noted in Article III, section 3.4 in the Preliminary Agreement, all commitments of the Nor-Am Cold Storage and Western Iowa Tech Community College under this Preliminary Agreement are subject to the condition that mutually agreeable terms of a permanent training agreement shall be reached on or before January 9, 2025. It is understood and agreed that if such a final agreement is not reached; neither Nor-Am Cold Storage nor Western Iowa Tech Community College shall be obligated to proceed with a training program.

Company Description:

Nor-Am Cold Storage is a full- service, public refrigerated warehouse. The company is evolving to meet the ever-changing needs of the market by providing complete temperature-controlled storage, processing, boxing, tempering and export services to the food and food service industry. The company plans to expand its operations in their Cherokee, Iowa location by hiring approximately 12 additional employees.

Recommendation:

It is the administrative recommendation that the Board approves the Preliminary Iowa New Jobs Training Agreement with Nor-Am Cold Storage.

The Employer acknowledges that any costs of the training project in excess of amounts available from New Jobs Training Certificates, and any debt service on the New Jobs Training Certificates in excess of amounts available from the new jobs credit from withholding, will be the responsibility of the Employer, and that the payments required to be made by the Employer under the Agreement will be subject to the provisions of Section 260E.3(5) of the Iowa Code.
